



# Sheet Music Ornament



**SKILL LEVEL: BEGINNER**

## **Supplies:**

**3" Foam Ball - White**

**Sheet Music (From Old Hymnal, Sheet Music Book or Scrapbook Paper) OR Book or Dictionary Pages cut into 1/2" x 5" vertical strips**

**1.5 yds Jute Twine - Natural**

**Modge Pod or Elmer's Glue in the Easy Squeeze Plastic Bottle**

**Ribbon or Rick Rack for embellishments cut into two (2) vertical strips**

**Greenery, pine cones, poinsettias, etc. for added embellishment**



## **Tools:**

**Glue**

**Scissors if needed**

**Paper Towels for clean up!**

## **Instructions:**

1. Apply a generous amount of glue to the front half of the foam ball. Attach the first strip from the top center of the ball down to the bottom center. Working left to right and attaching strips in order, attach more strips, slightly overlapping the previous one as you go. When the front of the ball is covered, apply glue and continue working around the back of the ball. Let dry.
2. Apply Ribbon or Rick Rack for embellishment. Attach the first ribbon with glue around the foam ball. Attach the second ribbon with glue crossing the first ribbon at the bottom of the foam ball.
3. Optional: For loops at the top, use the twine. Hot glue one end to the top center and make a 1 1/2" long loop, gluing to hold. Without cutting length, continue making similar loops next to each other, going all around the top of the ball, creating about seven loops.
4. Make one final loop 3" long as the hanger loop and glue the end back underneath the other twine at the top center. Let dry before hanging.
5. Add more Christmas embellishments with glue, such as greenery, pine cones, and poinsettias, to your liking.
6. Hang on your tree and ENJOY the Holiday Season!
