

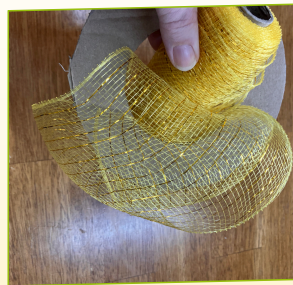


Mesh Ribbon Pumpkin

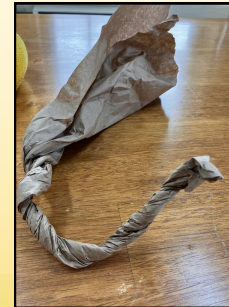
Included:

- 1 roll of mesh ribbon
- 2 pieces of brown paper
- 1 cardboard donut
- 1 piece of cut ribbon

Starting with your cardboard donut, start wrapping your mesh ribbon loosely. Continue to wrap the mesh ribbon around the cardboard by coming up and through the center hole. You will see your pumpkin shape start to emerge as you wrap. Once you've used all your ribbon tuck the end under so it doesn't unwind. (You can use glue to secure it, not included)



Make a stem for the top of the pumpkin out of brown paper. Begin by twisting the paper a few inches up from the bottom.



Once you have your stem wrap your extra piece of ribbon around the base of the stem. Crumple up the extra paper around the stem base and insert it into the center of the pumpkin. Fluff your paper to look like a pumpkin center. Apply glue (not included) to keep the paper in place. You can also glue the small cardboard piece to the bottom to keep it more stable.
