

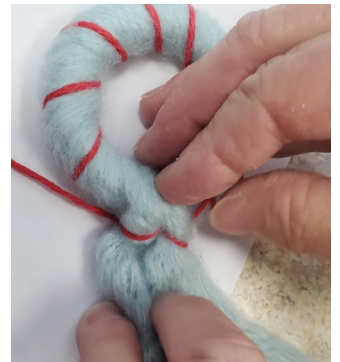
Cozy Wreath Ornament

Wood Ring, Fuzzy yarn, and Ribbon

1. Wrap the fuzzy yarn around the wood ring.
2. Tie at the bottom. Don't tighten the knot yet.
3. Wrap the ribbon around the wood ring.

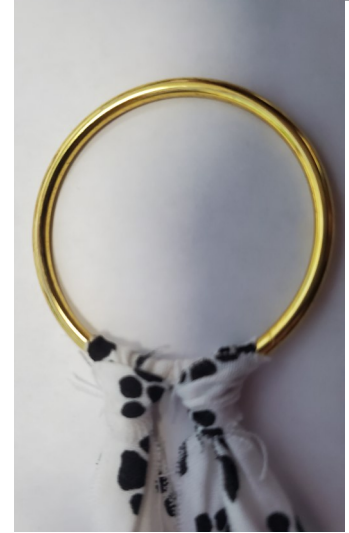


4. Leave enough to tie a bow at the bottom. To secure the ribbon pull through the yarn tie at the bottom.
5. Tighten the knot in the yarn.
6. Wrap the ribbon around to the back, then around to the front then make a bow.
7. Cut ends as desired.
8. Loop a ribbon at the top.



Mini Fabric Wreath Ornament

Metal ring, fabric strips and ribbon.



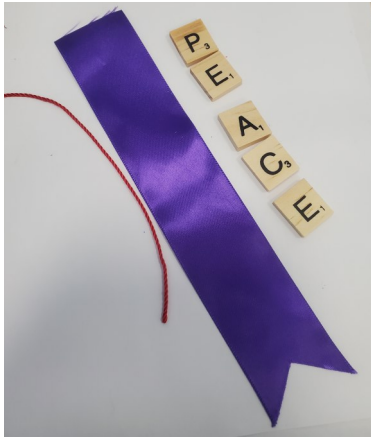
1. Fold you strip of fabric in half with the wrong sides together.
2. Place the fabric under the ring with the loop in the center.
3. Bring the ends of the fabric up and over the ring and though the fabric loop.
4. Pull and make a knot. Adjust as necessary.
5. Continue until the ring is full.
6. Use the ribbon to make a bow and a loop to place on the tree.

If you want, you can simply make a double knot over the ring edges giving you fabric on both sides.

Embellish as desired.

Words of Cheer Ornament

Ribbon, Scrabble tiles, and cord. Also you will need glue.



1. You may cut a notch at the bottom of the ribbon if desired.
2. Start with the gluing the bottom letter. Then with the next letter you can space them apart or put them next to each other.
3. Turn ribbon over.
4. The smaller cord is to hang it on the tree. Make a loop and knot.
5. Put a line of glue on the ribbon and loop the end. Attach the end where the line of glue is.
6. Embellish as desired.
